European Union Co-funded Project.
“Twinning In Community”
Quiliano and Ajdovščina, twin municipalities

The project “Twinning In Community” shared between the Municipality of Quiliano (Italy) and the Municipality of Ajdovščina (Slovenia), winner of the European call CERV-Town Twinning, with a score of 86/100, will start in the Municipality of Quiliano, Lead Municipality of the project, with a first event on the 6th, the 7th, the 8th of September 2024, titled “A gymnasium for democracy and reading to join,” and will then end with a second event, titled “From Literacy to reading through the Children's Parliament”, which will take place in the Municipality of Ajdovščina (Slovenia), the project partner, on the 7th, the 8th, the 9th of May 2025.

The main purpose of the project is to share good practices aimed at enhancing European citizenship in the territories through the active involvement of the two communities and the partners associated with the project.

The events will focus on some of the successful experiences implemented by the two countries involved to foster a greater involvement of young people in democratic life, for example, by making people know the Municipal Council of Boys and Girls (C.C.R.R.) of the Municipality of Quiliano, as well as the Children's Parliament of the Municipality of Ajdovščina, and by spreading bibliopedagogical experiences towards the most vulnerable groups, with the goal of independent use of information, also by using universal reading tools such as silent books.

The experimentation of shared cultural experiences will provide an opportunity for personal growth for the different target groups involved in the project: public administrators, students, cultural workers, teachers, citizens.

During the days in which the project will take place, group works, simulations and meaningful experiences will be organized and they will give to young people, and not only to them, the opportunity to share their ideas, develop curiosity, listening skills and the ability to argue and defend their opinions in a constructive way.
